The Schools Trust can assist schools in all aspects of staff recruitment, including candidate selection, organisation of venues, presence and advice during the interview stage and background checks.

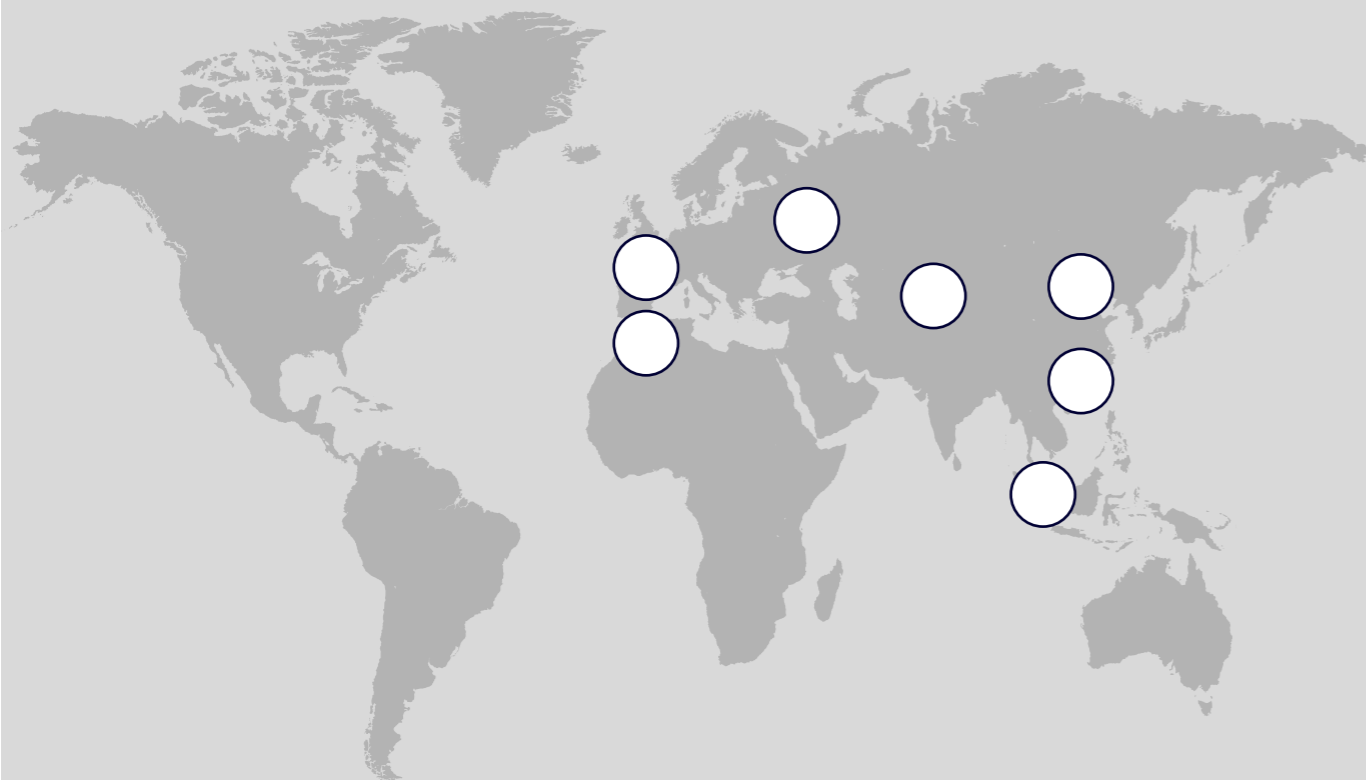

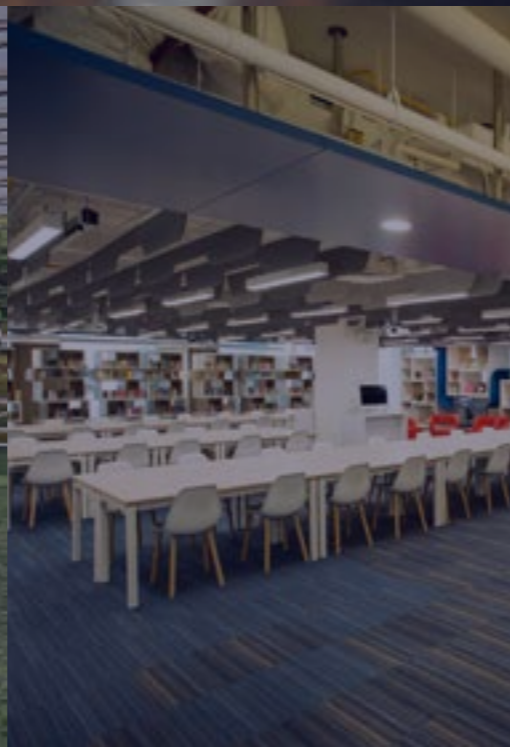
